Agreement for Backgrounding/Feeding Services

SERVICES: Landair, Inc. will background/feed your bulls in our pens and traps located on Brown Ranch in Bee County, Texas.

CHARGES FOR SERVICES: Your bulls will be provided with fully balanced growing and developing rations while in these pens/traps. The ration cost at this time is \$202.00 per ton, but will fluctuate with commodity prices. Yardage charges will also apply. These bulls will be weighed in/out upon arrival/departure. It is understood that these bulls have been weaned a minimum of 45 days prior to delivery to Landair Feedyard. The bulls need to have had all their weaning/BRD shots prior to arrival: at least two modified live (ML) BRD Complex vaccinations along with other necessary shots as recommended by your veterinarian. Assuming proper vaccinations have been given, it is further recommended that these bulls be "revac'd" shortly after arrival to, OR immediately prior to shipping to the yard. Chute/handling charges of \$1.50 per head will be charged for every trip down the chute for routine procedures such as revacs or doctoring. Additional charges will apply for procedures such as fertility testing and/or ultrasound scans, clipping/trimming and photos/videos.

SICKNESS/INJURY: In the event of any sickness, the bulls will be treated as directed by our consulting veterinarian. In the event of any serious lameness or injury, we will notify you for a decision as to what should be done with the bull in question. The cattle will be checked daily and treated as needed and we will do our best to promote their health and wellbeing, but we are in no case responsible for lameness, injury, sickness, or death losses from any cause. All death losses will be reported in writing.

BILLING: Landair, Inc. will bill you monthly via *EMAIL* for feed, yardage, and any other pertinent charges. Our backgrounding, feed, and services are "**for cash**", no credit is hereby extended, and bills are **DUE AND PAYABLE ON RECEIPT**. Late fees will be applied to any overdue bills. **FINAL FEED BILLS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE CATTLE LEAVE OUR FACILITIES.**

VACCINATION PROTOCOL “RECOMMENDATION” (Consult with your Vet)

- 1. Cattle weaned a minimum of 45 days**
- 2. Modified Live (ML) Respiratory Vaccination such as Pyramid 5, BoviShield Gold 5 or equivalent. Revaccinate according to label direction.**
- 3. Pasturella Vaccination such as Presponse HM or equivalent**
- 4. Blackleg vaccination**
- 5. Pinkeye vaccination**
- 6. De-worm**

Modified Live (ML) vaccine is much more effective than a Killed vaccine. Killed vaccines are used when vaccinated calves are still nursing their mothers. When calves are weaned then ML vaccines can be used. Again, consult with your vet.
