Sale Logistics:

- A total of up to 20 open heifers, 40 assorted 3n1's/Pairs and Bred Cows/Bred Heifers, and 15 Bulls will be accepted for the sale nomination. Cattle will be screened and selected 1st by Phenotype and Body Condition score. 2nd screen on Bulls, Bred Heifers and Open Heifers will be by EPD's and Performance Data. 3rd screen on Bulls will be DNA on file with BBU. (DNA on Bulls is preferred but not required.)

• **Cattle – Sale Condition – Must be in condition to be able to sell. Cattle must possess a minimum 5 body condition score. However, 6 or above body condition score is preferred.**

- Any member of BBU and a paid member of LSBBA is eligible to nominate cattle for this sale. If you are not a paid member of LSBBA, mail your 2022 dues of \$25.00, check to LSBBA and send to Randy Cook, Treasurer; 9925 CR158; Kaufman, TX 75142.
- Nomination Fee of \$50.00 per lot. (Non-Refundable).
- **Nomination Deadline: SEPTEMBER 30, 2022.**
- Cattle will be penned in catalog order.
- Display pens are available for \$100.00. If you have a lot in the sale, all efforts will be made to pen your display adjacent to your lot.
- Judging: All cattle will be graded by a panel of 4 - 5 judges - Friday, December 2, 2022. A buckle will be awarded to the top Female and the top Bull.
- A semen lot will be sold to support the sale.
- Steak Dinner and Fun Auction will follow Grading on Friday night. Dinner is complimentary for Members, \$10.00 per guest. Bring a fun auction item to help support the sale.
- Ranch Inspections are not required but are available. Please contact the Sale Chairmen – Kelly Cupp or Jerry Davis.

Health Papers: Must be dated within 30 days of sale and signed by licensed Veterinarian.

- A separate health paper (certificate) issued by a licensed veterinarian is required on each lot consigned.
- Animal ID # (Traceability Requirement)
- TB Free – Texas does recognize TB Free States and Brucellosis. You do not have to have a TB test unless you are from an area that requires it. If you have any questions, check with your vet, or go to www.tahc.state.tx.us. If you are out of state, check with your vet on health requirements.
- Bulls 18 – 36 Months Old.
 - Trich Tested
 - Fertility Tested and Scrotal Circumference
 - BSE (Breeding Soundness Evaluation) Test. BSE Form from BBU or form issued by the Society of Theriogenology may be submitted.
- Females – All females must be palpated, and results noted on health papers.
- Health papers must accompany all cattle upon delivery at sale site.

Bulls- 18 to 36 Months Old (Limit 15)

- Bulls with DNA recorded at BBU is suggested and criteria will weight in final selection of bulls after phenotype selection.
- Bulls are required to have EPD's – Weaning Weight and Yearling Weight.
- Performance Scan Data is required: Bulls must have Performance Scan Data criteria recorded at BBU. Scan Data Minimums will not be enforced but will be used in the final selection for the sale.
- Inspection: All Bulls will be inspected and screened by the Sale Chairman Kelly Cupp and the Sale Manager Anthony Mihalski. If the Consignor is within reasonable driving distance the bulls will be screened by Kelly Cupp, if not then screening will take place by video or photo. Bulls must possess a score of 1 or 2 conformation and underline score of 1,2 or 3 to be eligible to sell.

3-N-1's and Pairs (Age Limit 96 months, 8 yrs.)

- Female with calf at side age over 6 months must be palpated safe in calf and noted on health papers.

Bred Cows

- Bred Cows age limit maximum 96 months, 8 yrs.
- Bred Cows must have prior progeny listed with BBU or they are not eligible. (“P” or “C” BBU number on prior calves will be checked.)
- Bred Cow must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed vet and this information must appear on health papers

Bred Heifers

- Bred Heifer age limit 15 to 36 months
- Bred Heifer should have EPD's – Weaning Weight and Yearling Weight.
- EPD's and Performance Scan Data (scanned at ages 320 to 500 days) required and recorded at BBU.
- Must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed vet and this information must appear on health papers

Open/Exposed Heifers (Age limit up to 22 months of age)

- Heifers that do not palpate safe in calf on the health papers will be graded and sold in the open heifer category.
- Open heifers should have EPD's – Weaning Weight and Yearling Weight.
- EPD's and Performance Scan Data (scanned at ages 320 to 500 days) required and recorded at BBU.
