This scholarship program is sponsored by the B.E.E.F. to encourage junior members to continue their education beyond the high school level. This scholarship is for graduating High School seniors, students enrolled in a Junior College, or a four-year University. We will award (2) \$1,500 scholarships and (2) \$1,000 scholarships. The scholarship money will be funded to the college in the name of the student upon proof of admittance and enrollment to their specific Junior College or University. Winners will be announced at the JBBA National Show Awards Ceremony.

Candidates for the B.E.E.F. Scholarship must be actively involved in livestock activities. Applicants must either be a JBBA member and/or BBU member or can be a lineal descendent of a BBU member. The scholarship can only be applied to undergraduate studies. All applications for the scholarship will be reviewed without regard to the applicant's race, gender, religion, physical conditions or national origin.

Should the recipient fail to complete at least one semester of enrollment for any reason scholarship funds must be refunded to the B.E.E.F. Foundation.
