- Promote JBBA and help grow program
- Visit with new and interested JBBA members
- Offer new ideas (related to program, events, etc.)
- Represent JBBA in public relations and official events in a positive and professional manner
- Assist in working the arena(s) at various stock shows throughout the year
- Attend the JBBA National Show and Convention
- Attend the BBU Convention
- Write and submit article(s) to be published in The Beefmaster Cowman
- Write for the JBBA Journal (JBBA e-newsletter)
- Oversee portion of fundraising
  - Which includes, but is not limited to, raffle tickets, National Show and Convention sponsorships, and advertisements
  - Raise a MINIMUM of \$1,000 for the National Show and Convention
- Follow Board of Director responsibilities and requirements
